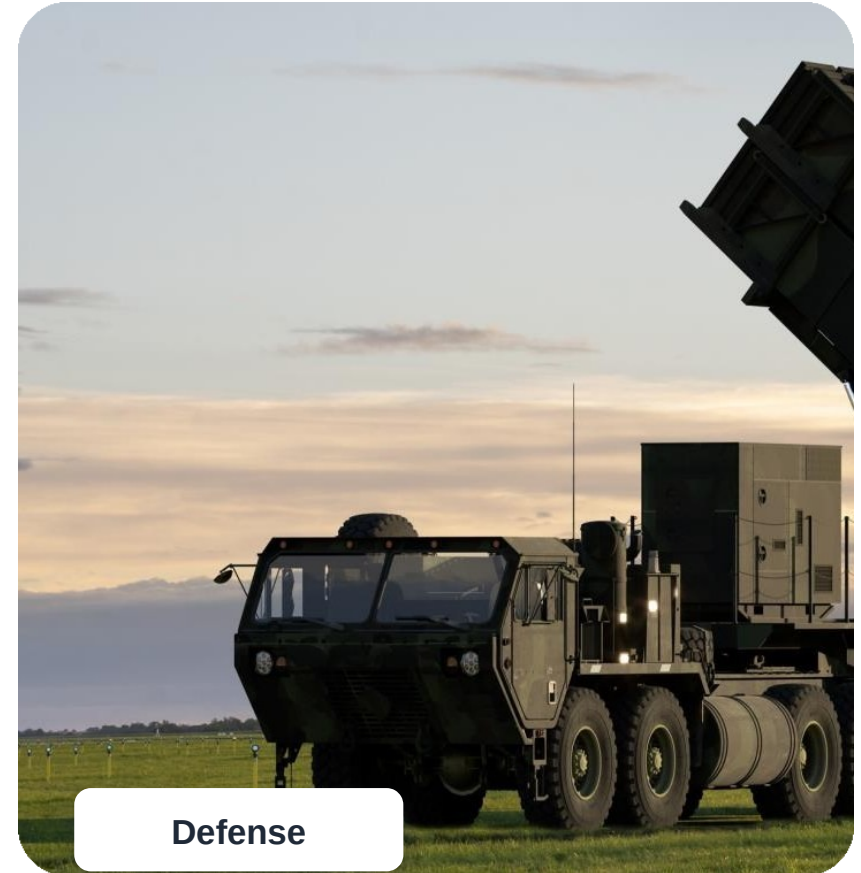

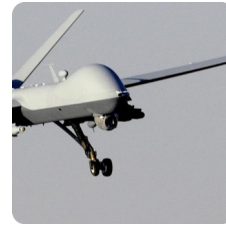
Pending acquisitions expand National Security strategy, platform and reach, along with planned renaming to NSM Labs, Inc. to underscore National Security Matters initiative.

Current: Defense & Aerospace Connectivity (EMI Solutions)

- High-reliability electromagnetic interference (EMI) filtering and connectivity solutions are designed to protect sensitive electronics.
- Deployed in defense and aerospace programs including F-22 Raptor fighter jets, Apache helicopters and Javelin Missile Systems and Boeing and Gulfstream aircraft.



Current: Wireless Systems, Sensors & Autonomous Platforms (RaGE Systems)

- Expertise in system design, development, and specialty manufacturing.
- Advanced RF/mmWave hardware, custom integrated circuits, embedded systems, sensor fusion, software, and system integration.
- Expanding sensing capabilities for threat detection, infrastructure monitoring, and remote UAS (drone) operations through deep expertise in imaging, radar, and mmWave sensing.
- Focused on high-value defense priorities, including precision weapons, secure communications, and electronic warfare.
